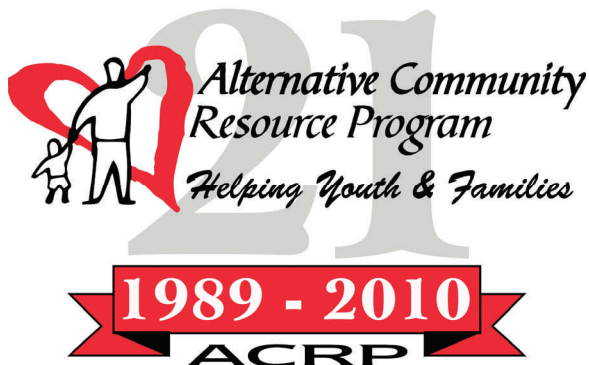

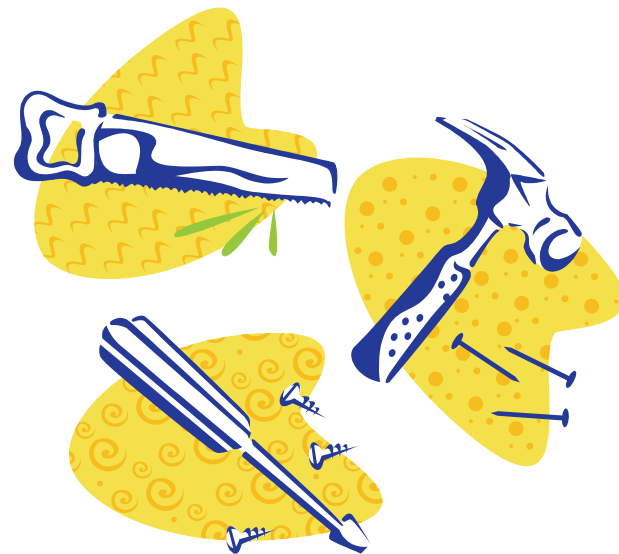

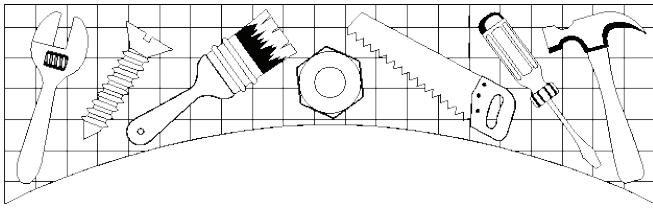

The Alternative Community Resource Program, Inc. (ACRP) in cooperation with the Cambria County Human Services Development Fund has developed a program to provide chore services throughout Cambria County. The program is for anyone living in Cambria County 59 years of age and younger. Federal poverty guidelines do apply.



Services may include, but are not limited to minor home repairs, minor electrical and plumbing repairs – weatherization materials, minor exterior painting, snow removal, grass mowing, fall clean-up, and minor exterior repairs. Other services may include installation of home safety items –smoke detectors, carbon monoxide detectors, deadbolts, peep holes, hand rails, railings, safety lights.
